

Merchandise Terms and Conditions Discloser Agreement

Thank you for partnering with us! We appreciate you!

This agreement is made on.....between MCHS Band Booster Club herein referred to as "Seller" and..... herein referred to as "Consignor."

Whereas Consignor wishes to sell item(s) (see attached inventory sheet) by consigning said item(s) and it is understood that Seller and Consignor agree to the following:

Consignor receives 70% of the selling price of their items! Consignor sets the price! Volunteers who also consign, will get 75% of their selling price in appreciation for their help with the event if they work at least one (4) hour shift.

If you had items that sold, we will mail your check within one week of the closing of the sale. Please make sure you provide us with a valid mailing address and a valid name. A valid phone number is essential as well.

There will be a non-refundable \$5 handling fee for each gown, due at the time of consignment. Collected up front from the Consignor whether the dress sales or not, it helps cover advertising expenses and supplies. Jewelry, shoes and other accessories to complement the prom gowns will be accepted with a gown consignment. The handling fee is only charged for each gown.

Consignors selling at least 1 acceptable prom dress will be given a special preview ticket to attend the presale. One adult ticket (for parent/guardians only) and one student ticket. Non transferable.

Dresses are to be hung on sturdy plastic or wooden hangers on a size large enough that the item does not fall easily fall off the hanger (with the hook pointing to the left to make a question mark when held in front of you.) Strapless gowns should be hung using the sewn in straps on the inside of the dress (like displayed in the stores). We will be allowing customers to try on the dresses so please DO NOT safety pin the dresses to the hangers. Accessories (hair, jewelry and gloves) are to be placed inside a Ziploc baggie and stapled shut.

Those whose gowns have not sold will be notified and must be picked up. You can begin to pick up any unsold items on Sunday, February 20th from 6:00-8:00 PM, and on Monday, February 21st, 12:00 pm till 8:00 pm. All unsold items can be donated if not picked up during that time unless you have made prior arrangements . We will make every effort possible to NOT donate your unsold items unless you abandon them. They will be returned to you if at all possible! You will need to make arrangements to have them picked up ON TIME! No exceptions please! If you cannot pick up your dress (ID will be required for pick-ups/drop-offs) you must designate who can be allowed to pick up your items here:

Every effort is made to protect your items; however, Seller is not responsible for any loss or damage due to fire, flood, storm, theft, accident, other Acts of God or any other cause. Consignor agrees to hold harmless and make no claim against, MCHS Band Booster Club, MCHS Band Booster Members Individually, Murray County High School, MCHS Marching Indian Band, owner or leaser of the space where the sale is held, any volunteers or paid participants of MCHS Band Boosters Consignment Sale.

Consignors who desire to earn a higher commission (up to 75%) and early shopping privileges must agree to work a volunteer shift. The consignor agrees that if a volunteer shift is not worked, they will not receive a higher commission and early shopping privileges, they will receive the standard 70% commission rate. There will be a sign in sheet.
